POOL OPENING - Dover pool will open for the season on Saturday, May 25, (weather permitting). The pool will be open daily 11:00 am to 6:00 pm. Admission is \$3.00 per person. A 12-punch swim pass is available for \$30.00. Punch passes can be purchased at the pool.

SWIM LESSONS - Students must be age 6 and completed kindergarten to enter the swim program. There are six levels to this swim program. First session is July 8-19. Second session is July 22-Aug 2. Fee is \$15.00 for each session. Students may use goggles in lessons, but no mask.

<u>POOL PARTY RENTAL</u> - Swimming pool reservations begin Monday, May 20, for the 2019 season. Reservations will be taken at the Parks and Recreation office, 2421 N. Wooster Ave., Monday thru Friday, 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Individuals, families or groups may rent the pool any evening from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm. Pool rental dates will start on Monday, June 3, and end Sunday, August 11. Rental fee of \$90.00 is due at the time of pool reservation. Pool rentals are limited to one per person and are on a first come, first serve basis.

BASEBALL CAMP will be conducted by Dover's baseball coach Jeff Fondriest and his staff. This is a fundamentals camp focusing entirely on instruction for ages 8-14. Camp will be Mon-Wed, June 24-26, 9:00-11:00am. Fee \$35.00.

BASKETBALL CAMP is open to all boys and girls in grades 3-6 next school year. The camp will be held Mon-Wed, July 29-31, 8:30-11am, on the outdoor courts in the park. Camp director is Dover's basketball coach Bob VonKaenel. Fee \$30.00.

<u>TECHNIQUE SWIM CAMP</u> will be offered for grades 1-12 next school year, with Brenda Wherley, Dover's swim coach. Camp will be held Mon-Thur, Aug 5-8, 8:30-10:30am. This class will work on technique for each stroke in swimming. Fee \$40.00

FOOTBALL CAMP will be held Mon-Wed, July 8-10, 9:00-11:00am. This camp is for grades 1-8 next year, and will be conducted by the Dover Varsity Football staff and members of the 2019 varsity team. Fee \$30.00.

SOCCER CAMP will be offered to students K-8 next school year, instructed by John Loffredo, president Dover Soccer Assn. Camp will take place Mon-Thur, June 10-13. Campers must wear shin guards and bring own soccer ball. Fee \$40.00.

<u>TENNIS LESSONS</u> are offered for students ages 5-17, by Kevin Knoch, Tennis Professional. Fee for Munchkin (ages 5-7) and Junior's (ages 8-11) is \$30.00. Fee for Junior's (ages 12-17) and Intermediate-Advanced (ages 11-17) is \$40.00. First session is June 10-27. Second session is July 8-25.

<u>Start/ReStart Tennis</u> is offered for adults, ages18 and up, by Kevin Knoch, Tennis Professional. They meet Thursdays, June 20-Aug 1, 6:30-8:00pm. There will be no session on July 4. Fee \$60.00.

<u>CHEERLEADING CAMP</u> will be held Mon-Wed, July 8-10, 9:00-11:00am. This camp will be conducted by Courtney Rees, high school cheerleading coach, and the Dover High School cheerleaders. This camp is for grades 1-6 next school year. Fee \$35.00.

PICNIC SHELTER RENTAL - Reservations for picnic shelters start on the first working day of each new year. Four shelters in Dover City Park can be rented for family reunions, picnics, etc., from May 26-Sept 8. The fee for half a shelter, which can seat 45-50 people is \$15.00. An entire shelter seats 90-100 people and rents for \$25.00. Reservations can be made at Parks and Recreation office, 2421 N. Wooster Ave. The picnic shelter along the pool road is on a first come, first serve basis.
