**POOL OPENING** - Dover pool will open for the season on Saturday, June 3, (weather permitting). The pool will be open daily 11:00 am to 6:00 pm. Admission is \$3.00 per person. A 12-punch swim pass is available for \$30.00. Punch passes can be purchased at the pool or park office.

<u>SWIM LESSONS</u> - Students must be age 6 and completed kindergarten to enter the swim program. There are six levels to this swim program. First session is June 19-30. Second session is July 10-21. Fee is \$15.00 for each session. Students may use goggles in lessons, but no mask.

<u>POOL PARTY RENTAL</u> - Swimming pool reservations begin Monday, May 15, for the 2023 season. Reservations will be taken at the Parks and Recreation office, 2421 N. Wooster Ave., Monday thru Friday, 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Individuals, families or groups may rent the pool any evening from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm. Pool rental dates will start on Friday, June 9, and end Sunday, August 6. Rental fee is due at the time of pool reservation. Pool rentals are limited to one per person and are on a first come, first serve basis.

**BASEBALL CAMP** will be conducted by Dover's baseball coach Jeff Fondriest and his staff. This is a fundamentals camp focusing entirely on instruction for ages 8-14. Camp will be Mon-Wed, June 12-14, 9:00-11:00am. Fee \$35.00.

**BASKETBALL CAMP** is open to all boys and girls in grades 3-6 next school year. The camp will be held Mon-Wed, July 24-26, 8:30-11am, on the outdoor courts in the park. Camp director is Dover's basketball coach Bob VonKaenel. Fee \$30.00.

**FOOTBALL CAMP** will be held Mon-Wed, June 19-21, 9:00-11:00am. This camp is for grades 1-8 next year, and will be conducted by the Dover Varsity Football staff and members of the 2023 varsity team. Fee \$30.00.

<u>TENNIS LESSONS</u> are offered for students ages 5-17, by Kevin Knoch, Tennis Professional. Fee for Munchkin (ages 5-7) is \$30.00 and Junior's (ages 8-12) is \$45.00. Fee for Junior's Beginner/Intermediate (ages 12-17) is \$45.00 and Advanced (ages 12-17) is \$55.00. First session is June 6,8,9,13,15, & 16. Second session is June 27,28,29,30 and July 6 & 7.

<u>Start/ReStart Tennis</u> is offered for adults, ages18 and up, by Kevin Knoch, Tennis Professional. They meet Thursdays, dates TBD, 6:30-8:00pm. Fee \$60.00 for individual and \$110.00 per couple.

<u>CHEERLEADING CAMP</u> will be held Mon-Wed, June 19-21, 9:00-11:00am. This camp will be conducted by Courtney Rees, high school cheerleading coach, and the Dover High School cheerleaders. This camp is for grades 1-6 next school year. Fee \$35.00.

**DANCE CAMP** dates TBD, 9:00-11:00am. This camp will be taught by the Dance Force, and will be held outside of Dover Middle School. This camp is for grade 1-6 next school year. Fee \$35.00

<u>SOCCER CAMP</u> will be offered to students K-6 current school year, instructed by John Loffredo, president Dover Soccer Assn. Camp will take place Mon-Thurs, June 5-8. Campers must wear shin guards and bring own soccer ball. Fee \$45.00.

<u>PICNIC SHELTER RENTAL</u> - Reservations for picnic shelters start on the first working day of each new year. Four shelters in Dover City Park can be rented for family reunions, picnics, etc., from May 28-Sept 5. The fee for half a shelter, which can seat 45-50 people is \$15.00. An entire shelter seats 90-100 people and rents for \$25.00. Reservations can be made at Parks and Recreation office, 2421 N. Wooster Ave. The picnic shelter along the pool road is on a first come, first serve basis.
