<u>**POOL OPENING</u></u> - Dover pool will open for the season on Saturday, May 24, (weather permitting). The pool will be open daily 11:00 am to 6:00 pm. Admission is \$3.00 per person. A 12-punch swim pass is available for \$30.00. Punch passes can be purchased at the pool or park office.</u>**

<u>SWIM LESSONS</u> - Students must be age 6 and completed kindergarten to enter the swim program. There are five levels to this swim program. First session is June 9-13. Second session is June 16-20. Third session is June 23-27. Fee is \$15.00 for each session. Students may use goggles in lessons, but no mask. SIGN-UPS FOR DOVER RESIDENTS BEGINS ON MAY 5. SIGN-UPS FOR NON-DOVER RESIDENTS BEGINS MAY 12.

<u>POOL PARTY RENTAL</u> - Swimming pool reservations begin Monday, May 12, for the 2025 season. Reservations will be taken at the Parks and Recreation office, 2421 N. Wooster Ave., Monday thru Friday, 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Individuals, families or groups may rent the pool any evening from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm. Pool rental dates will start on Thursday, June 6, and end Sunday, August 3. Rental fee is due at the time of pool reservation. **Pool rentals are limited to one per person and are on a first come, first serve basis.**

<u>BASEBALL CAMP</u> will be conducted by Dover's baseball coach Jeff Fondriest and his staff. This is a fundamentals camp focusing entirely on instruction for ages 8-14. Camp will be Mon-Tues, June 9-10, 9:00-11:00am. Fee \$35.00.

<u>BASKETBALL CAMP</u> is open to all boys and girls in grades 3-6 next school year. The camp will be held Mon-Wed, July 28-30, 8:30-11am, on the outdoor courts in the park. Camp director is Dover's basketball coach Bob VonKaenel. Fee \$30.00.

<u>FOOTBALL CAMP</u> will be held Mon-Wed, June 23-25, 9:00-11:00am. This camp is for grades 1-8 next year, and will be conducted by the Dover Varsity Football staff and members of the 2025 varsity team. Fee \$30.00.

<u>**TENNIS LESSONS</u>** are offered for students ages 5-17, by Kevin Knoch, Tennis Professional. First session will be Tuesday's/Thursday's from June 10-26, and second session will be Tuesday's Thursday's from July 8-24.</u>

<u>Start/ReStart Tennis</u> is offered for adults, ages18 and up, by Kevin Knoch, Tennis Professional. This will be held on Thursday nights from 6:30-8:00pm, June 19-July 24 (excluding July 3). The cost is \$50.00. There must be at least four players registered for the class to run.

<u>CHEERLEADING CAMP</u> will be held Mon-Wed, June 23-25, 9:00-10:30am. This camp will be conducted by Courtney Rees, high school cheerleading coach, and the Dover High School cheerleaders. This camp is for grades 1-6 next school year. Fee \$35.00.

DANCE CAMP will be held July 28-30, 9:00-11:00am. This camp will be taught by the Dance Force, and will be held outside of Dover Middle School. This camp is for grade 1-6 next school year. Campers must wear shin guards and bring own soccer ball. Fee \$45.00.

PICNIC SHELTER RENTAL - Reservations for picnic shelters start on the first working day of each new year. Four shelters in Dover City Park can be rented for family reunions, picnics, etc., from May 24-Sept 7. The fee for half a shelter, which can seat 45-50 people is \$15.00. An entire shelter seats 90-100 people and rents for \$25.00. Reservations can be made at Parks and Recreation office, 2421 N. Wooster Ave. The picnic shelter along the pool road is on a first come, first serve basis.
